Fear not! This is only temporary. The fountain pumps are in need of replacing, and the City's Division of Parks and Recreation, who




maintains the park, is waiting for the new replacements to arrive. Work is expected to be complete by mid- to late-October, according to City Spokeswoman, Susan Straub.

Thoroughbred Park was built by the civic-minded Triangle Foundation and has been a beautiful entrance to downtown since it opened in 1992.

Town Branch Trail Repair





Wondering what the construction on the section of Town Branch Trail, between South Mill and South Upper Street, is all about?

Due to a Kentucky Utilities project, a section of the trail had to be taken up, as utility lines along Vine Street running parallel to the trail are buried. While this can create extra work when lines are in need or repairing or replacing, this greatly benefits the appearance of Downtown Lexington Management District.

The great news is the KU project is complete! Workmen began pouring concrete last week to rebuild that block of the popular trail. The city is urging KU to complete the restoration ASAP!
